25-027-Attendance and Apologies for Absence- *To receive and record* – Cllr G Thompson- Apology accepted by Council

25-028-Declaration of Interest- Members are invited to declare disclosable pecuniary interests and other interests in items on the agenda as required by the Code of Conduct for Members and by the Localism Act 2011. No interests declared.

25-029-Minutes of Previous Meeting- For Approval & Signature of the minutes of the meeting held 9th JUNE 2025. The minutes of the 9th of June meeting were declared correct and signed by the Chairman.

25-030- Open Public Forum – The public is invited to speak on items relevant to the parish. This shall take no longer that 15 minutes and time is shared with all speakers. A member of the public reported that a leak in the street had been reported to the water company.

25-035- Code of Conduct. To review, discuss and adopt an updated Code of Conduct. Council voted to accept the suggested Code of Conduct with some corrections to typographical errors.

25-036- Co-option of new councillor-*To discuss the search for a new councillor and decide on how to proceed.* Thank you to Hilary Sutton for all her years of service. It was proposed to co-opt Andrew Foreman as new councillor. Mr Foreman has confirmed he is interested and qualifies to be a councillor. Council votes to accept Andrew Foreman. Clerk to invite to next meeting and forward introductory information to him.

25-037- Creation of Staff Committee-*To review, discuss and decide on the members and meeting date for a new Staff Committee.* It is agreed that Cllr G Thompson, Cllr S Husher and Cllr G Dominey will be on the staff committee.

25-038-Village Maintance Group- To review, discuss and decide if the Council can create and support a group to tidy and do some gardening around the village. Clerk to investigate if the insurance will cover volunteers and what kinds of risk assessments or other paperwork might be necessary. Further discussion at next meeting.
